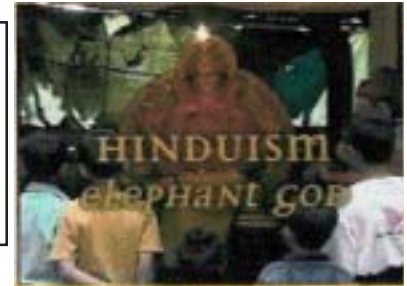
WORLD RELIGIONS SERIES

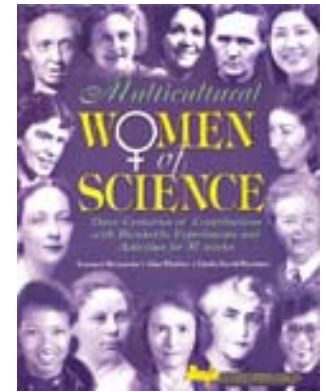

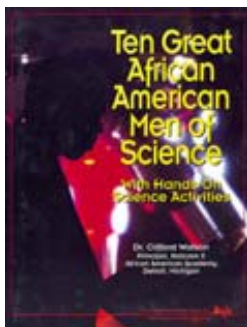
